A brief look at 43rd Dundonald.....

43rd Dundonald F.C. was founded in 1975 and is affiliated to 43rd BB and Old Boys Association (Dundonald Presbyterian Church).

In their first three seasons from 1975, 43rd set a record at that time by winning the BBOB League Divisions 5, 4 and 3 in consecutive seasons. Whilst winning Division 3, they remained unbeaten for an entire season.

Several 43rd players have played representative football for the Belfast Battalion. The Club then joined the DAWFL in 2003/04 and entered a 2nd team into the DAWFL in 2007/08. 43rd has a reputation as a friendly and fair Club who try and bring through young players who are leaving the Boys' Brigade.
